I am a PhD student at the University of Sydney conducting research about women who have died in the context of intimate partner violence. I hope to learn more about female homicide victims experiences of Apprehended Domestic Violence Orders (ADVOs) from the perspective of their family, friends' and supporters'.

Participation would involve one interview of about 1 and half hours.

In Order to determine if you are eligible for the study a brief telephone interview will occur where you will be asked if:

You are a family member, friend or supporter of a female intimate partner homicide victim, who held an ADVO at any stage prior to or at the time of her death.

You have knowledge of the woman's help-seeking for example, her attempts to utilise ADVOs.

You have knowledge of the intimate partner violence perpetrated against the woman.

And you had contact with the woman in the twelve months pre-ceding her death.

If you meet the above criteria you will then be sent a Participant Information Statement and Participant Consent Form to consider if you would like to take part in this study.
